Jesus M Banales is [Professor of Molecular Biology](#) and Head of the Liver Diseases Group at the [Biodonostia](#) Health Research Institute – Donostia Univ. Hospital in San Sebastian (Spain). His multidisciplinary group is chiefly focused on studying the molecular mechanisms involved in liver pathobiology, with special attention to cholangiocarcinoma, and looking for novel diagnostic and therapeutic strategies. He is also Prof. Sciences at the Univ. Navarra (Spain), and Assistant Prof. Medicine/Sciences at Mayo Clinic (Rochester, MN, US) and Univ. Area Andina (Colombia). Professor Banales is author in >170 research articles published in referent international Journals, including 46 in cholangiocarcinoma, has obtained >40 research projects as PI funded by National and International Institutions (including EU Horizon 2020), is inventor of 5 patents (3 licentiated), and is Member of the Editorial Board of *Hepatology*, *Nature Reviews Gastroenterology & Hepatology*, *Liver Transplantation*, *Seminars in Liver Diseases*, *Cells*, and Special Section Editor of *Journal of Hepatology*. He coordinates numerous research network including our [COST Action EURO-CHOLANGIONET](#) and the *European Network for the Study of Cholangiocarcinoma (ENS-CCA)*
