RESEARCH FIELD (please insert here a brief summary of the research interests of your lab).

The focus of my current research is the investigation of the plasticity and heterogeneity of the tumor microenvironment in primary solid tumors and liver metastasis, with a special focus on cancer-associated fibroblasts and cholangiocarcinoma. Investigating the dynamic plasticity of cancer-associated fibroblasts and tumor cells during cholangiocarcinogenesis, will allow to decipher, dissect, and reprogram these cells toward a therapeutically favourable phenotype, for the development of new combined therapeutic therapies.

Supported by national and international funding including the prestigious ERC starting grant awarded in 2022 and guaranteeing time and funding protection until end 2028, in our laboratory we provide the opportunity to develop both technical and soft skills.

Joining our laboratory, the candidate will acquire new technical skills including patient-derived 3D cell cultures (avatar spheroids and organoids), transgenic animal models, primary and metastasis liver tumor models in mice, The Chicken Egg Chorioallantoic Membrane (CAM) Models, induced pluripotent stem cells, highthroughput technologies including spatial transcriptomics, single cell RNA sequencing, Multiome and biocomputational analysis.

The candidate will also develop soft skills including teamwork and communication, thanks to the weekly lab meeting and the participation to national and international conferences as well as lab activities and training courses. The adaptability, critical thinking, time management as well as problem solving capabilities will also be developed with the main goal to accompany the fellow toward the next step in her/his carreer.
